Key Vocabulary

Bible	also known as the Holy Bible, is a group of religious texts of Christianity.
Old Testament	the first part of the Christian Bible, which talks about how the earth was created by God and was all written before Jesus arrived on earth.
New Testament	the second part of the Christian Bible, written after Jesus lived on Earth and introduces us to him, his birth, life and how he died to save humans on earth from their sins.
God	In Christianity, God is believed to be the eternal, supreme being who created and preserves all things.
Creation	the making of the world by God.
Fall	a term used in Christianity to describe the transition of the first man and woman from a state of innocent obedience to God to a state of guilty disobedience.
People of God	a term used in Christianity to refer to Christians.
Incarnation	means 'to take on flesh'. For Christians, the incarnation shows that Jesus was fully God and fully human.
Gospel	is the good news that Jesus Christ lived a perfect life, died a death that we deserved and rose again to save those who will follow Him.
Salvation	is a word for getting "right" with God. We get saved when we believe in Jesus.
Kingdom of God	the domain over which God reigns as King. So, wherever God is 'in charge,' that's where his kingdom is.
