



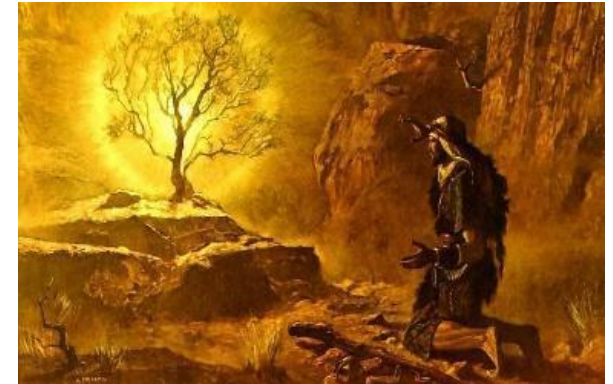
Big question: How did belief in God affect the actions of people in the Old Testament?

Knowledge Organiser – People of God

Key vocabulary:

- **Bible:** Holy scriptures for Christians.
- **Old Testament:** That part of the Canon of Christian Scriptures which the Church shares with Judaism, comprising 139 books.
- **Faith:** Trust, obedience, loyalty, devotion. A gift from God,
- **Blessing:** A special favour between God and the individual/humankind.
- **Covenant:** Agreement/promise made between two or more people.
- **Vocation:** See background knowledge for teachers.
- **Calling:** Following the voice of God.
- **Selflessness:** More concerned with the needs of others rather than self.
- **Sacrifice:** Making an offering to God. Offering oneself for God's service.
- **Trust:** A **bold, confident, sure security or action based on that security.**
- **Prayer:** Having a conversation with God.

Abraham – promised millions of descendants.
