### **What has been happening this week?**

**Nursery** children have learned all about *The Nativity* this week and have made a small world installation with camels, palm trees, wooden houses and the characters from the story. There have been many brilliant questions asked by the class about which animals are in the story? Why does the angel know Jesus and why did Jesus get a lamb for Christmas? The class have been making collages of Christmas trees and snowmen both requiring sorting of small, medium and large shapes. We have been getting into the Christmas spirit and our cooking this week was mince pies, which all the children ate heartily.

**Year 4** have successfully completed their painting art project today where they used our new paint brushes to paint their dragons which they have taken lots of time with drawing small, intricate details such as individual scales.

This week **Year 5** visited the National Army Museum as part of our science unit on forces. We learnt about different types of parachutes and how the forces of gravity and air resistance affect their speed. In teams, we designed and made our own parachutes and tested them. Did you know some parachutes have a hole in the centre so they can travel more accurately to their target?
