After School Clubs – Spring Term 2026

Arts and Crafts Club (Reception, Years 1-2) Run by Dance & Arts. Let your creativity shine! Our Arts & Crafts Club invites children to paint, cut, glue and create exciting projects each week. Fun, hands-on, and full of imagination!

Backgammon Club (Years 4-6) Open to all Year 4 to 6 students, whether you're brand new to the game or already a seasoned player. You'll learn the rules, sharpen your thinking skills, and enjoy friendly matches with classmates. Come challenge yourself, make new friends, and become a backgammon master—no experience needed! The club is run by Ms Christopher and one of our parents, Mr MacPherson

Chess Club (Years 3-6) This is a junior chess programme run by Willesden and Brent Chess Club, an English Chess Federation accredited club, and is open to all levels of ability, from beginner to expert. A chess coach will be present for those just starting out – so don't be shy, come on by!

Coding Club (Years 2-6) Code Ninjas offers the opportunity to learn real coding languages such as Python and Coffee Script through their own custom program which is suitable for all ages and levels of experience.

Crochet Club (Years 4-6) Run by Ms Sayers, the children will be taught to crochet and complete simple projects to take home.

Drama Club (Rec & Years 1-2) Again run by Dance & Arts, both Drama Clubs will focus on encouraging creativity, improving communication skills and confidence through fun and engaging drama activities, such as role-playing, improvisation, and simple performance projects.

Earth Club (Years 2-4) Run Moving Waves, this is a creative and engaging club designed to raise environmental awareness through hands-on-activities and games, students will connect with nature and explore sustainability in fun, imaginative ways.

Fashion Rebellion Sewing Club (Years 4-6) Created by Amanda Riley, a designer, teacher, environmentalist and founder of The Fashion Factory, 'Fashion Rebellion' the eco fashion school, is an online programme with the easiest of step-by-step video tutorials so that anyone aged 8 years and above can learn to use a sewing machine. Once they are confident with using a machine the children will design and make their own items using old fabrics, including a pencil case, tote bag and a hair scrunchie.

Fencing Clubs (Years 1-3) and (Years 4-6) Run by Andrew Grass, a senior fencing coach and NASM personal trainer from the United States where he trained fencing students from the level of beginner to national finalists. The lessons will go over the basics such as how to hold the blade, rules of the game, simple strategies, referee basics and more.

Football Clubs (Years 1-3) and (Years 4-6) Children warm up with exercises, practise skills and play competitive games. *Children must wear PE kits and trainers.*

Gymnastics Club (Rec & Year 1) and (Years 2-4) These clubs will be run by Dance & Arts: Our experienced coaches will guide the children through floor-based routines, helping them build strength, flexibility, coordination, balance, core stability and grace. Take the leap and let your kids soar with us at the Gymnastics Club! *Children must wear PE kits and trainers.*

Lego Club (Rec-Year 2) Using activity ideas from the EYE organisation (Educating Young Engineers) children will be given basic engineering challenges to complete each week.

Multisports Club (Reception, Years 1-2) Run by Mr Djabate, our Kenzalia Club leader, this club will offer age appropriate sports activities in a friendly, fun and safe environment. *Children must wear PE kits and trainers.*

Netball Club (Years 3-6) This club is run by Active Day Camps and focuses on developing key skills for matchplay. Children will focus on dynamic drills, agility development and ball handling before playing a match at the end of each session.

Pottery Club (Years 1 & 2) Run by Moving Waves, the children will be taught different air clay forming techniques to produce ornaments, tiles and figures, which will then be painted. The projects will be based on current topics within the school curriculum.

STEM Club (Years 1-3) and (Years 4-6) Run by Aveea Academy the children will work on different STEM projects each week, for further information see their website: <https://www.aveea.org/aveea-academy/>

Storytelling Club (Reception and Year 1) Debutots interactive storytelling and dramatic play classes develop children's confidence to speak, concentration to listen and their creative and critical thinking. Children explore complex themes and feelings in a safe and happy environment through storytelling and drama techniques.

HOW TO BOOK AND PAY ON SCHOOL GATEWAY

1. Log on to School Gateway (download the app as this is clearer)
2. Click on the name of your child if more than one child is showing
3. Click on the club that you wish to book.
4. Click on make a booking.
5. Booking Choice—only click on Pupil Premium/Free School Meals if you have a filled out a form that has been authorised by Brent Council. The reduced rates are not available for children receiving universal free school meals.
6. Click on the dates that you want to book from the list of available dates.
7. Click on Book.
8. Click on Pay Now.
9. Click on the club you have booked.
10. Add to basket.
11. View basket and checkout.
12. You will receive an email confirming payment.
13. If you want to book another club or child after step 10 go back to step 2 and repeat steps.

Please do not make a payment before you have made the booking, as the payment may be taken and the booking not confirmed.
