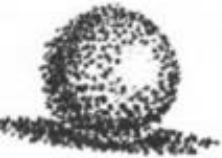

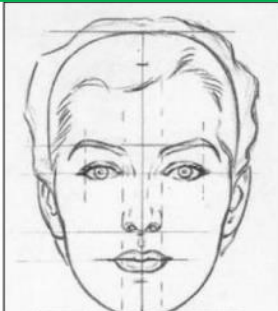
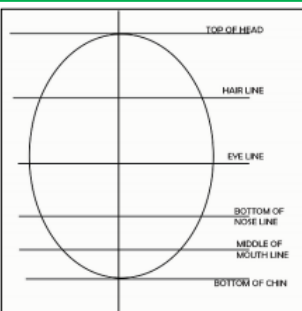
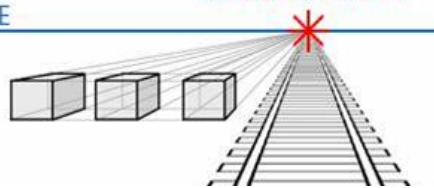


Develop perspective in using a single focal point and horizon.

VANISHING POINT

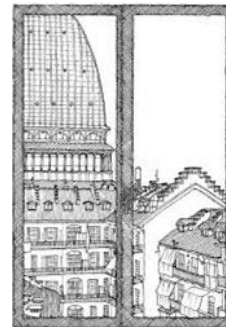


The Eyes are positioned halfway between the top of the head and the chin. The bottom of the Nose is positioned halfway between the eyes and the chin. The Mouth is positioned half way between the bottom of the nose and the chin.

## Key Vocabulary and definitions

- **Horizontal:** Lines going across the page
- **Perspective:** a way of showing objects on the flat surface of a picture so that they seem the correct size and distance from one another.
- **Portraiture** is the art of representing a person. It can take the form of a drawing, painting, photograph or sculpture.
- **Scale:** the size of an object in relation to another object.
- **Self-portrait:** is a representation of an artist that is drawn, painted, photographed, or sculpted by that artist.
- **Subject:** the objects you are drawing
- **Vanishing point** – the spot on the horizon to which the object or scene appears to recede towards.
- **Vertical:** Lines up or down a page
- **Viewfinder:** A window to select focus area for drawing
