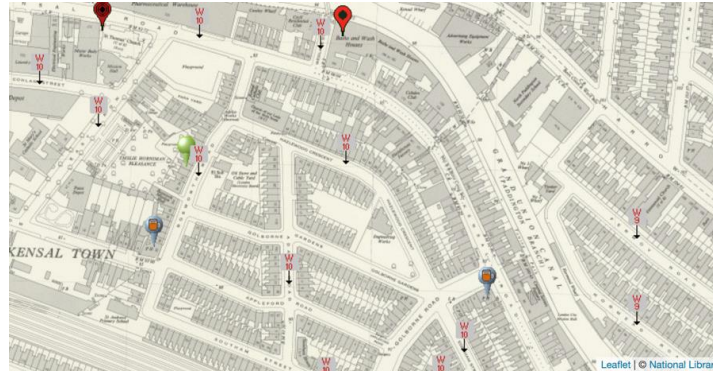

Local history	The study of history in an area close to where someone lives, works or attends school.
wash house bomb site living conditions Leisure time	The area in the baths where people did their laundry.
baths	A building for public washing and laundry.
debris	Scattered rubbish or remains of something that has been destroyed.
laundry	Washing and drying clothes and sheets.
The Blitz	The Blitz was a period of heavy bombing of British cities by the Germans as part of World War 2.
Post-war Britain	The period after WW2 (1950s and 1960s) in Great Britain.
oral account	A spoken version of events, which reflects a personal opinion by a person.
primary source	A historical source which was created at the time e.g. an artefact, relic, monument, photograph, painting
